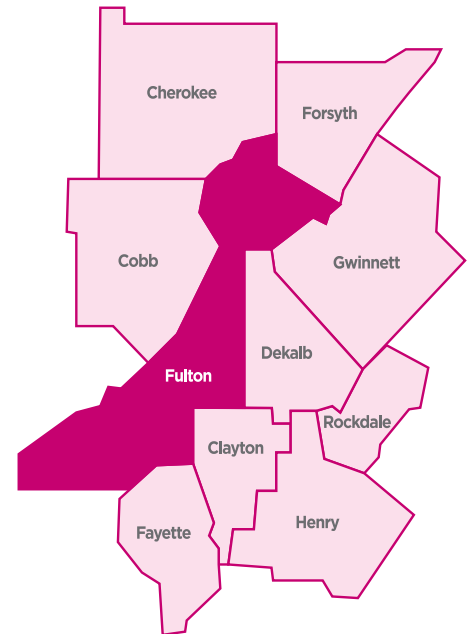


KOMEN ATLANTA COMMUNITY PROFILE 2010



FULTON COUNTY

Susan G. Komen for the Cure Greater Atlanta Affiliate is the local resource for breast cancer screening, treatment, education and support. Through events, including the Race for the Cure, and contributions, the Affiliate raises funds to enable women to detect and survive breast cancer. The organization conducts a biennial Community Needs Assessment to discover the status of breast health, breast cancer and related services within the Affiliate's 10-county service area. Komen Atlanta's extensive grants program addresses those unmet needs and disparities by funding breast health programs in the community for the medically underserved.

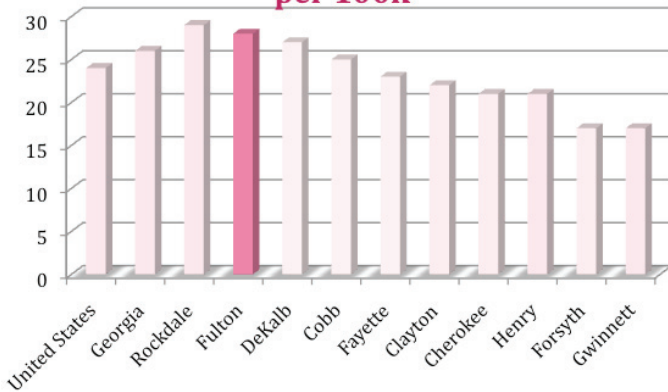

In the Komen Atlanta Service Area:

- Fulton County has the largest general population and the largest female population in the Komen Atlanta service area.
- Fulton currently has the 4th highest breast cancer incidence among females at 123.09 new cases per 100,000 people. Based on trend data, this rate is expected to rise with Fulton having the 3rd highest incidence by 2014.
- Fulton has the 2nd highest percentage of women being diagnosed with late stage breast cancer.
- Fulton has the 2nd highest mortality rate within the service area.
- Fulton has the 4th highest number of women ages 40 and older who have not received a mammogram in the past 12 months.
- Fulton County has the highest percentage of uninsured women between the ages of 18-64 within the service area (25.5 percent as compared to the service area average of 16.2 percent).
- Fulton has the 2nd highest number of families living below the poverty line (11.5 percent as compared to the service area average of 2.9 percent)

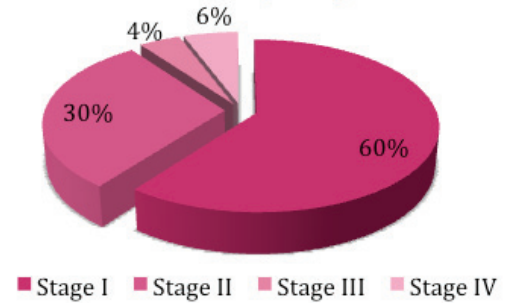
2009 Service Area Mortality Rates per 100k



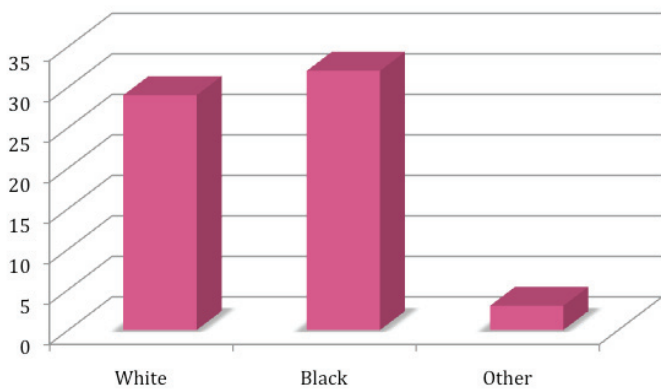
- THE FACTS -

The mortality rate due to breast cancer in Fulton County is 27.88 per 100,000 people. This is slightly higher than the service area mortality rate of 23.94.

2009 Fulton Breast Cancer Incidence by Stage

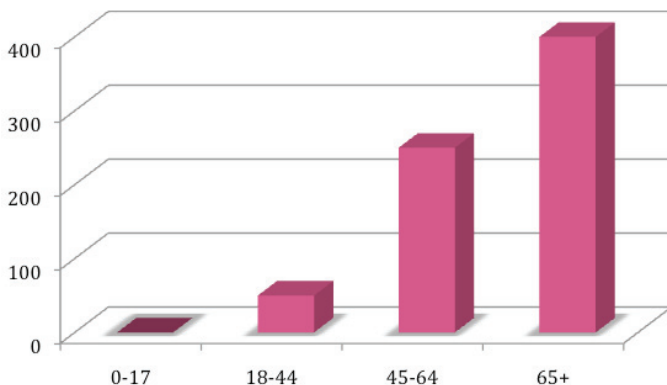


2009 Fulton Mortality Rate by Race, per 100k
