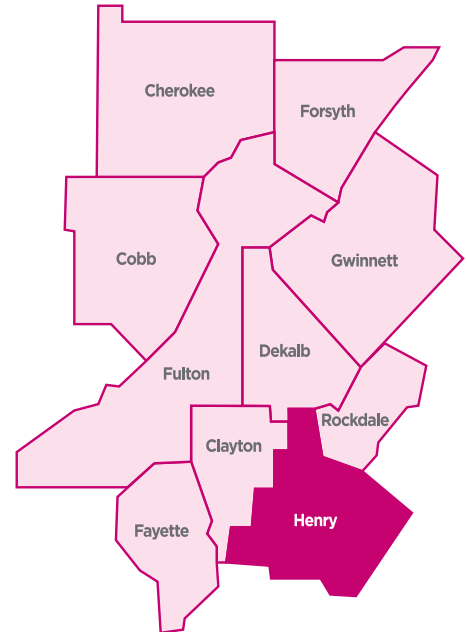


KOMEN ATLANTA COMMUNITY PROFILE 2010



HENRY COUNTY

Susan G. Komen for the Cure Greater Atlanta Affiliate is the local resource for breast cancer screening, treatment, education and support. Through events, including the Race for the Cure, and contributions, the Affiliate raises funds to enable women to detect and survive breast cancer. The organization conducts a biennial Community Needs Assessment to discover the status of breast health, breast cancer and related services within the Affiliate's 10-county service area. Komen Atlanta's extensive grants program addresses those unmet needs and disparities by funding breast health programs in the community for the medically underserved.

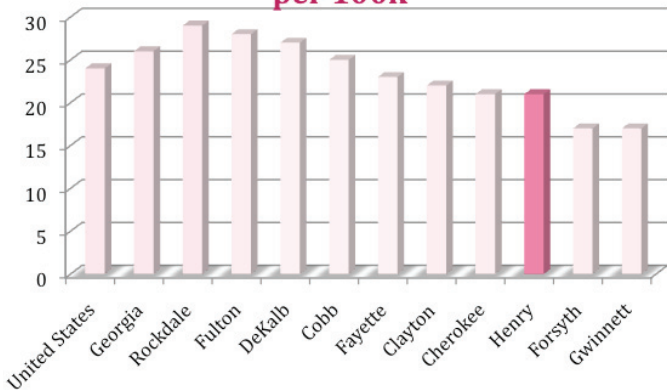

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In the Komen Atlanta Service Area:

- Henry County has the 7th largest population within the Komen Atlanta service area.
- Henry currently has the second lowest incidence of breast cancer among females in the service area
- Henry ranks 4th in the service area for percentage of late stage diagnosis.
- Henry has the 3rd lowest mortality rate within the service area.
- Henry ranks 5th in the service area in terms of women 40 and older not receiving mammograms
- Henry has the 3rd smallest number of uninsured women.
- Henry has the 6th highest percentage of families living below the poverty level.

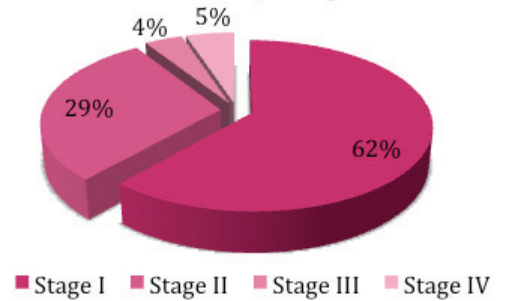
2009 Service Area Mortality Rates per 100k



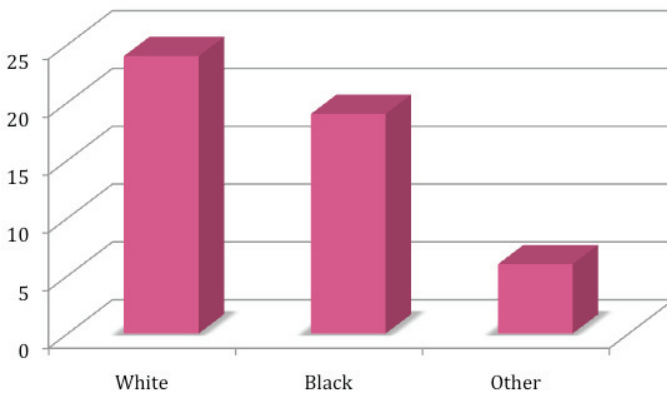
- THE FACTS -

The mortality rate due to breast cancer in Henry County is 20.88 per 100,000 people. This is slightly lower than the service area mortality rate of 23.94.

2009 Henry Breast Cancer Incidence by Stage

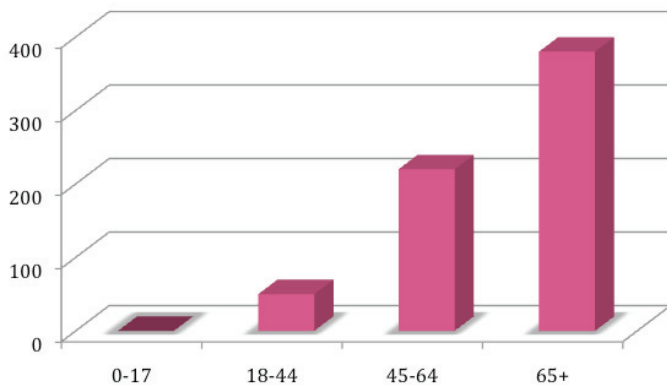


2009 Henry Mortality Rate by Race, per 100k
